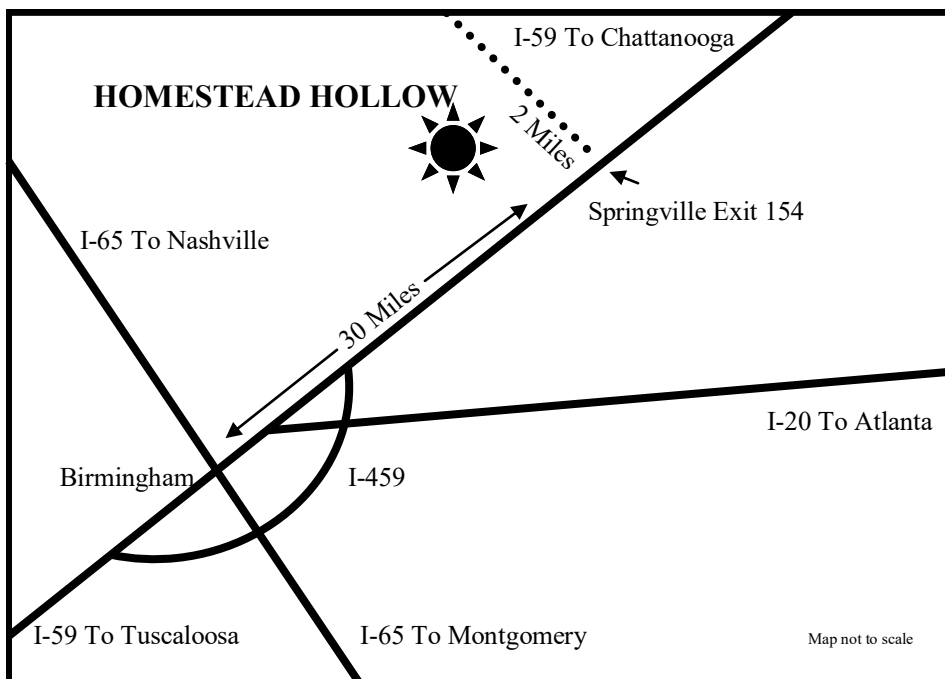

Homestead Hollow's is proud to present our 2017 festivals featuring fine arts, hand made/hand decorated crafts, antiques, pioneer demonstrators, live entertainment, food, and children's activities. These 3 day festivals are family oriented and advertised by TV, radio, flyers, newspapers, magazines, billboards, and the internet.

Our festivals have been quite successful since 1982. We have approximately 150 booths from fine arts, handmade crafts, hand decorated items, antiques, and demonstrators exhibit at each show.

Homestead Hollow is located in Springville, Alabama, just 2 miles off I-59, exit 154.



## APPLICATION PROCESS:

The festivals are juried shows and applications will be approved or rejected based on creativity, quality, originality, and booth display.

Exhibitors are limited to 2 categories per booth. Exhibitors must furnish at least 4 photographs of finished work to be sold, 4 photographs of work in progress including at least 1 photo of artist/crafter at work, 4 photographs of raw materials, and 1 photograph of a booth set-up for a total of at least 13 photographs. **No slides, picture cds or photos by email will be accepted.** Photographs will not be returned and will be kept for our files. Good, quality photocopies of photographs will be accepted. All work exhibited must be comparable to work shown in photographs.

***Only complete applications will be considered by the jury committee. Complete applications include:***

Application, filled out and signed.  
Required photographs.  
Booth fees.

Following acceptance, exhibitors will receive an acceptance notification by email (for vendors that have email) or letter via US Mail with set-up information. **Once accepted, no refunds will be given.** Check or money orders of exhibitors not accepted will be returned.

## WEATHER:

Homestead Hollow is a rain or shine event. The festival does not close during intermittent rain. In the event of prolonged, inclement weather, the festival may delay opening or be cancelled with no refunds given. It is the responsibility of the vendors to be present for notification of delays or cancellations.

## **FESTIVAL RULES AND RESTRICTIONS:**

Vendors may only sell their own work which is handmade and/or hand decorated.

Buy/sell items are allowed as long as those items compliment the hand made/hand decorated items and can only account for 10% or less of total merchandise or booth space. Example, belt buckles not hand made/hand decorated go with belts that are hand made/hand decorated. If you have any questions, please call the office for clarification.

Vendors are only allowed to display and sell items which have been juried and approved. Example, if you did not list jewelry on your application, you are not allowed to sell jewelry.

Vendors shall be present during the entire festival to display and/or sell his or her arts/crafts.

Artist are allowed to sell copies of their own, original works of art.

Antique/vintage items are eligible for participation. These items are to be in good condition and predate 1960. Items to be sold can include metal, glass, fabric or paper, no plastics allowed. These items may be sold as is and do not have to be altered to be sold.

Limited booths have extra space behind the booth. This space is available to rent for an additional fee. This area is not to

be used for extra display area, only storage or personal use.

Storage containers are not to be left in view. Booths must be neat and have a pleasing appearance. Booths are designated with wooden stakes. No booths, racks, merchandise, or other items are to exceed the boundaries of your booth.

No vehicles or trailers will be permitted in craft area during festival.

**ABSOLUTELY**, No alcohol, drugs, profane language or vulgar conduct.

Homestead Hollow reserves the right to terminate the participation of any festival participant at any time with no refund.

### **SET UP AND CHECK IN:**

Only white, off white or tan tents are allowed for art/craft vendors. Vendors may begin checking in at the cabin office on Wednesday 4:00 pm to 7:00 pm; Thursday 9:00 am to dark; Friday 6:00 am to 7:30 am (not available for new vendors). Vendors must be set up by 8:30 am on Friday. Vendors are responsible for tents and other display units. A card with the exhibitors name will be provided and must be displayed on booth. Name tags will also be provided and need to be worn at all times. You may continue to set up past the check in time.

**ALL VEHICLES MUST BE REMOVED FROM FESTIVAL AREA BY 8:30 AM PRIOR TO OPENING TO THE PUBLIC.**

### **SALES TAX:**

All vendors are required to charge, collect and pay city, county and state sales tax. Tax papers are provided in registration packets. Payment of taxes is the responsibility of the vendor, we do not collect sales tax. We provide a list of vendors to the State of Alabama.

### **CLEAN UP**

Do not leave any garbage on the ground, especially plastic ties. Vendors that leave garbage on the ground will be banned from participation at future events.

### **PARKING/CAMPING/ SECURITY:**

Parking passes will be furnished and must be displayed on dash/mirror of vehicle with booth number written on pass. Vendors must park in designated area. Limited RV hook-ups are available (electricity & water). Security is provided Thursday through Saturday night. No pets are allowed in vendors section during festival.

#### **RELEASE/INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT:**

For and in consideration my being allowed to participate in the indicated Homestead Hollow festival, I, the undersigned applicant, do hereby agree to release, acquit and forever discharge Homestead Hollow, it's members, officers, agents, employees, servants, successors and assigns and all other persons, firms, corporations or other legal entities sponsoring, promoting, or otherwise associated with any Homestead Hollow festival, from any and all claims, lawsuits, demands, actions, causes of actions, whether sounding in tort, contract, or other theory of law, whether for compensatory or punitive damages, whether known or unknown, which have previously existed now exist or could hereafter exist, arising from, connected with or otherwise related in any way whatsoever to my participation in any Homestead Hollow festival. And further more I do hereby agree to indemnify and hold harmless Homestead Hollow for the payment of any claim, demand or judgment arising out of or related to my participation in any Homestead Hollow festival, including the payment of the costs, expenses and reasonable attorney's fees incurred by Homestead Hollow.
